The field this year includes Bingham, Clearfield, Corner Canyon, Davis, East, Evanston, Fremont, Herriman, Kemmerer, Layton, Mountain View (WY), Northridge, Riverton, Rock Springs, Syracuse, Viewmont, and Weber. Some individual athletes from other schools may also be in attendance.

## MEET INFORMATION AND ENTRY INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. The meet will be state qualifying.
- 2. The fast heats will run first in every event.
- All entry will be through the South gates of the stadium. There will be separate entrances for 3. coaches/athletes and spectators.
- Canopies are not allowed in the west bleachers. Canopies in the east bleachers and grass areas outside the 4. track are fine.
- 5. Everyone will be guaranteed 1 mark if it is under the minimum line:

- To facilitate seeding, athletes should report to the starting line or field event area at first call. 7.
- 8. Shot Put, Discus, Javelin and Long Jump contestants will have three (3) attempts in the trials. The top nine (9) will advance into the finals for an additional three attempts.
  - a. Individual events and relays will be scored: 10 8 6 5 4 3 2 1
- 9. Because of the quality of the field, we will score eight (8) places, and will include marks from all heats and flights.
- 10. The discus will begin at 3:00 for Group A: Bingham, Clearfield, Corner Canyon, Davis, East, Evanston, Fremont, and Herriman.
- Shot put will begin at 3:00 for Group B: Kemmerer, Layton, Mountain View, Northridge, Riverton, Rock 11. Springs, Syracuse, Viewmont, and Weber.
- Group A and Group B will switch events at the completion of their flights. 12.
- Athletes making finals in the Shot Put will be called back to the shot put ring around 4:30 Discus finals will follow at about 5:00. Athletes in the finals with conflicts in other events should communicate with the field event official.
- Javelin will be an open runway for the entirety of the meet. The finals will begin promptly at 5:30 (finalists will be called back prior to finals), all trials throws must be done before 5:30 (No Exceptions).
- 3-4 heats will be contested in the 800 and 1600 runs. Heats will be arranged with the top 14-18 runners placed in the fast (first) heat, and the remainder in the slower heats.
